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1. Description of the personal protective equipment model:

PPE category: third category

EC type-examination certificate 0161/23867/16

Type of PPE: footwear protecting against thermal risks and molten metal splashes as found in foundries and welding conforming to standard EN ISO 20349:2010

Model: B – Ankle-high footwear

Classification: I - Footwear made from leather and other materials, excluding all-rubber or all-polymeric footwear

Sizes available: from 38 to 47 (French sizes)

Shape identification: U3716

Processing: Injection moulding

The footwear comes with:

non-metallic toecap code "PU00040" – 604 MARCA

metallic penetration-resistant insert, code "LA00002" - SAFIT

removable insole code "TL00051"

The footwear features a protective toecap that protects against a 200 Joule impact and crushing risks under a maximum 1500 daN load.



2. The examinations and tests to verify model compliance (in accordance with art. 11A of Directive 89/686/EEC - Decision 768/08/EC Module C2) are carried out by applying the following harmonized standards and Regulation 1907/2006/EC Annex XVII, as amended (where applicable).

- EN ISO 20349:2010 - Personal protective equipment — Footwear protecting against thermal risks and molten metal splashes as found in foundries and welding — Requirements and test method.
- EN ISO 20344:2011 - Personal Protective Equipment - Test methods for footwear.
- EN ISO 20345:2011 - Personal Protective Equipment - Safety footwear.

4. Features offered by the personal protective equipment model:

From the tests and examinations conducted, there is proof that the PPE examined conforms to the model described in the EC type-examination certificate and that there is uniformity of production.

The Determination of characteristics model according to EN ISO 20349:2010. The ankle high safety footwear art. "SO10213 BULLS S3 HRO HI WG SRC" complies with:

the basic requirements of the safety footwear specified in Table 2 of EN ISO 20349:2010 standard; and to the following additional requirements for special applications taken from Table 2 of EN ISO 20349:2010 standard:

(Category A-E-P-WRU-FO-HRO-WG-HI1)

- closed heel area;
- antistatic properties;
- energy absorption in the heel area;
- water penetration and absorption resistance of the upper;
- penetration resistance of the base of the footwear;
- resistance to hydrocarbons of the sole;
- heat resistance through contact with the sole;
- resistance to molten metal splashes for welding footwear (WG);
- resistance to contact heat of the base (level "HI1");
- sole with cleats.

The footwear meets all the requirements of standard EN ISO 20345:2011 regarding slip-resistance of its sole ("SRC" requirement).

The Personal Protective Equipment and its components show no trace of the dangerous substances listed in Annex XVII of Regulation 1907/2006/EC, as amended.

- the article code: SO10213 BULLS S3 HRO HI WG SRC
- the regulatory references: EN ISO 20349:2010 (see notes)
- the symbols relating to the protection provided and/or the relevant category:

- Manufacturer's brand: "U POWER"
- symbol indicating a garment protecting against heat and flame (ISO 7000-2417)
- information pictogram symbol (ISO 7000-1641)
- size of footwear.

6. Notes:

- "Making available on the market": supply of a product for distribution, consumption or use on the Community market in the course of a commercial activity, whether in return for payment or free of charge.
- "Placing on the market": the first making available of a product on the Community market.
- "Manufacturer": a natural or legal person who manufactures a product or has a product designed or manufactured, and markets that product under his name or trademark.
- "Representative": any natural or legal person established within the Community who has received a written mandate from the manufacturer to act on his behalf for specified tasks with regard to the latter's obligations under the relevant Community legislation.
- "Harmonized standard": a standard adopted by one of the European standardisation bodies listed in Annex I to Directive 98/34/EC on the basis of a request made by the Commission in accordance with art. 6 of said Directive.
- "Accreditation": attestation by a national accreditation body that a conformity assessment body meets the requirements set by harmonised standards and, where applicable, any additional requirements including those set out in relevant sectoral schemes, to carry out a specific conformity assessment activity.
- "Conformity Assessment": process demonstrating whether specified requirements relating to a product, process, service, system, person or body have been fulfilled;
- "Recall": any measure aimed at achieving the return of a product that has already been made available to the end user;
- "Withdrawal": any measure aimed at preventing the making available on the market of a product in the supply chain;
- "CE" Marking: a marking by which the manufacturer indicates that the product is in conformity with the applicable requirements set out in Community harmonisation legislation providing for its affixing.
- The contents of this EC Test Certificate refers only to the personal protective equipment model examined.
